**ELIGIBILITY**

Any woman artist may submit for jurying **ONE** original work.  
Giclees, photography, computer generated images, crafts, work done under instruction, derived from published photographs or previously shown in a CLWAC Annual Open Juried Exhibition NOT eligible. Work by Members shown in the Members' Exhibition is eligible.

**2-DIMENSIONAL ARTWORK**

Eligible media: Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, Pastel, Graphics, Collage, and Mixed Media. Artwork, including frame, must not exceed 42" in width or height. All 2-D work must be framed, wired and ready for hanging. Gallery-wrap is permitted. Plastic glazing is required if metal frame is used and is recommended if work is shipped.

**3-DIMENSIONAL ARTWORK**

Sculptors must submit 2 views (except for wall hangings.) All sculpture must be light enough for one person to handle. Wall-hung work must be equipped with a hanging device. Ceiling-hung works or installation works are NOT eligible. Do not submit very small sculptures. There are no small display cases for very small work. Sculptors living within 50 miles of Salmagundi Art Club must provide their own pedestals or pay an additional \$25 pedestal rental fee.

**RECEIVING DAY** Sunday, June 19, 2022 - 8:30-12:00 noon. Accepted works will be received only on the date and during the hours specified. Artwork must arrive unpacked, whether delivered by artist agent, at The Salmagundi Art Club, 47 Fifth Avenue, New York, NY 10003. Shipper should receive work in advance to allow its timely **transport** to the gallery. Name given to your shipper must be identical to your Online application. Two available shippers are:

## 2-DIMENSIONAL AWARDS JURORS

**Sylvia Yount** - *Lawrence A. Fleischman Curator in charge of the American Wing, The Metropolitan Museum of Art.*

Sylvia is responsible for the administrative and curatorial oversight of the American Wing. Previously, she held curatorial leadership positions at the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts, the High Museum of Art, and the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts. She received a PhD and a MA in the history of art from the University of Pennsylvania and a BA in Italian from New York University.

**Vijay Kumar** – *Artist & Printmaker. Owner Manhattan Graphic Center.*

Born in India, Vijay Kumar studied art at Triveni Kala Sangam in New Delhi, and learned printmaking at Pratt Graphics Center in Manhattan. Drawing has always been his major interest. Vijay is a founding member of Manhattan Graphics Center, where he teaches etching. He has also taught printmaking at the Visual Arts Center of New Jersey in Summit and at the Center for Contemporary Printmaking in Connecticut. Vijay has exhibited his etchings, drawings and paintings throughout the U.S. and abroad and has won awards for his work.

She has won many prizes including the National Sculpture Competition, The National Sculpture Society Merit Scholarship, Honorable Mentions in the Society's publications, and is a two-time recipient of the Reutershan Trust Sculptor in Residence in Sag Harbor, NY.
